Akz Hole and I decided to do the run on Thursday morning in an effort to beat the afternoon heat and sun. Since the route was familiar and I had recently done the trail for a different Chapter, I was confident of finding the way.

The trail started on the left of the badminton court where we saw 3 pieces of Harriet logo paper clipped in all directions (i.e. the girl was upright, face down and on her back.) Going up the trail I noticed the marked absence of any other Chapter's papers except for the lone, thin plain white strip clipped sparsely along the way. Luckily having done the trail recently we were able to follow the marked path, even so, Akz Hole was continually stopping though to check where the next

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marker was. It was a big contrast to the last time when the trail was well marked but had used too much paper to guide the way. There must be a happy medium somewhere!

As we came up the path which, in bygone days, was the usual start of the skirt-ing the paper went up a steep way between two rocks but then turned down at the top to join the same path we were already on and I did wonder what was the point of it?

Walking on and forever looking for the sparse paper I was somewhat disappointed with the lack of Harriet logo paper and wondered what had happened to the previous well marked trail?? We eventually arrived at a bar but could not break it even after 20 minutes of looking in all directions and even calling the Bunny for advice. We knew the ridge was up above and decided in the end to head for that and pick up the paper once again when we hit the top which is exactly what we did. (The bar defeated pretty much everyone on the run including the Bunny herself who was only vaguely aware of the direction the true trail went. It was broken by Iceman with the Bunny's help but late on and caused no end of delay. The way was back down the hill from the bar and then to the right it seems but even then was hard to find!...Ed). It was suggested that someone had picked up paper but that is hard to believe as there was plenty of paper around especially on the ridge, enough for a bonfire in fact!

When we hit the ridge we turned left towards Bkt Gambier and eventually found the check for the On Down. There were lots of other papers around but no Harriet logo paper which made it hard to decipher what to follow. We knew the trail was going to head down on the other side of the hill and following the path we found the paper. It was a long and torturous route and the very dry shaley ground made one tread very carefully for fear of skiing down the slope. Over rocks and dried streams until emerging at the fish ponds by the small bridge leading to the Chinese shrine. It was then back to the runsite along the usual pathway.

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In the evening the confused pack came out in all directions and even Iceman ended up following the wrong trail but rescued Toddy Tan on the way down. I must admit the check was a good one but the good run was marred by the sparseness of the paper and with no sign of Harriet logo paper it was no wonder some got themselves confused.

The Bunny made up for it though with delicious food including Gado Gado with peanut sauce which had the Hashers going back for more time and again. We had our usual short circle and then quite a number stayed around chatting and drinking late into the evening.

Thank you to Speedhound for the hosting, the delicious food and good run. Despite the hiccups it was an excellent evening and very enjoyable.

They went up and over the ridge, met a friendly local hiker, who somewhat showed / brought them / followed them back down to the Elsa & Jasper concrete staircase back down to the badminton court. They came down lower than the "fish pond" / temple halfway up the hill.
2. Bommy went to the left, up and over the ridge, met a generator even... then reversed back over the ridge to come back and find the pack... he said he was feeling good, yesterday!
3. Hash Eugene scrambled right... over the slopey granite on the right, with some difficulty, and over the ridge also, and somehow made his way back to the run-

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site. Like Woody and Viking, he cut back to the concrete staircase before the “fish pond”. He met Toddy along the way (Toddy has made a 4:30pm start) and they both made their way down together...

4. Bommy went back to find that the Bunny herself seemed somewhat slightly lost, and busy dropping new paper on the ground for all to follow... a conscientious and hardworking Bunny, if ever, ha ha!

The really good thing about all this, is that by using a slightly different route, Nisha’s sunglasses, which had been lost while she and Anjalai were setting run a couple of weeks back for Nisha’s Rainforest Run, suddenly showed itself!

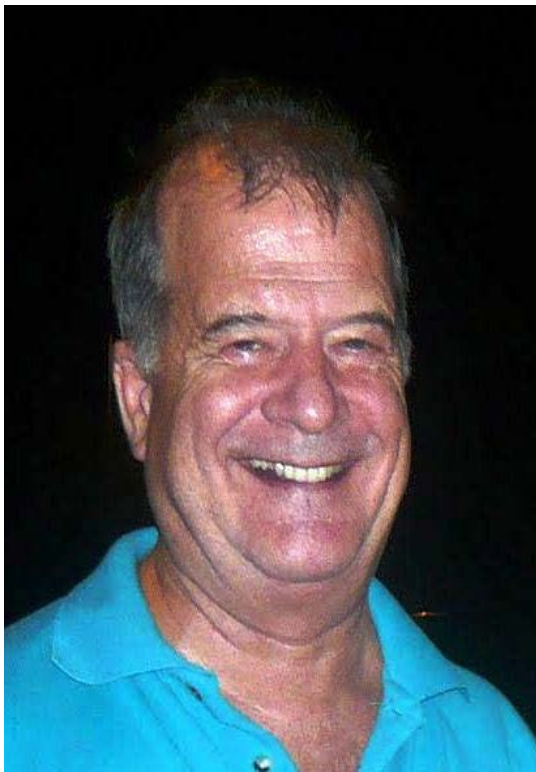
